- · Determine and validate control measures:
- · Develop, implement and maintain the water safety plan;
- · Define monitoring of control measures;
- · Verify effectiveness of WSP;
- · Prepare management procedures;
- · Develop supporting programmes;
- · Plan and carry out WSP reviews:
- · Revise WSP following incident;
- · Integrate WSP and climate change.

Target group

The training is aimed at all individuals involved in the management of drinking water quality, including operational staff of water supply systems, officers from government agencies, community supply managers and NGO project staff.
